



**PUBLIC DISCLOSURE NOTICE:  
FOND DU LAC TRIBAL AND COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

The following public information is provided by the Higher Learning Commission (the Commission) regarding Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College (the College). The Higher Learning Commission is a regional accrediting agency that accredits institutions of higher learning in the 19 states of the North Central region.

**What is the accreditation status of Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College?**

Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. It has been on Notice. On November 3, 2011, the Board of Trustees (the Board) of the Commission determined that the College had resolved the concerns of the Commission that led to the Notice. The Board removed the College from Notice.

**What are the next steps for Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College in the Commission's processes?**

The Board scheduled the College for a comprehensive evaluation in 2014-15, a one-year extension from the previously scheduled date of 2013-14.

**What is the history of accreditation review that led to this situation?**

Following a comprehensive evaluation visit in October 2009, the Board of Trustees took action to continue the College's accreditation on Notice because the institution was pursuing a course of action that, if continued, could lead it to be out of compliance with the Criteria for Accreditation due to concerns related to leadership, resources, planning, and assessment. The College submitted a Notice Report in July 2011 and hosted a focused visit to validate the evidence in the report in August 2011. Commission staff recommended to the Board that the College be removed from Notice.

November 10, 2011
